### SHIP SECURITY ADVISORY NO. 05-25

**To: Owners/Operators, Masters, Company Security Officers, Recognized Security Organizations**

**Subject: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR VESSELS ARRIVING AT UNITED STATES PORTS FROM CERTAIN COUNTRIES**

**Date: 15 April 2025**

This Ship Security Advisory (SSA) supersedes SSA No. 09-22.

In accordance with 46 United States (US) Code § 70108 and the US Department of State's designation of the Republic of Cuba as a State Sponsor of Terrorism, the US Coast Guard (USCG) has determined that Cuba is not maintaining effective anti-terrorism measures in its ports. This determination does not apply to US Naval Station Guantanamo Bay.

Actions required as listed in paragraphs C and D of [US Port Security Advisory 1-25](#) took effect for all commercial vessels that arrive in the US on or after 2 April 2025, after visiting ports in Cuba (excluding US Naval Station Guantanamo Bay) as one of their last five ports of call. Therefore, effective immediately, actions required in paragraphs C and D of the above referenced advisory are required for vessels that arrive in the US after visiting ports in Cuba (excluding US Naval Station Guantanamo Bay).

Please be reminded that all ships submitting Advance Notice of Arrival with the US are also required to copy the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) Maritime Administrator (the "Administrator") via email at [NOA@register-iri.com](mailto:NOA@register-iri.com).
